Whereas, this 3rd annual “Welcome Home El Dorado Slow Ride” will be held on Saturday, September 20, 2014, beginning in Pollock Pines at the Crystal View Station, with the route winding through the West Slope communities and ending at the Folsom Point Picnic Area; and

Whereas, the “Welcome Home El Dorado Slow Ride” event encourages public participation, with friends and neighbors, businesses and non-profits, to participate as riders, supporters and sponsors and has been made possible by the generous contributions of Cold Control, Panera, Crystal View Station, Jim Goodman and Cast Music Productions, KCRA TV and DBI Beverage; and

Whereas, public displays of appreciation are encouraged along the route that winds through El Dorado County foothill communities from Pollock Pines to Camino, Placerville, Shingle Springs, Cameron Park and El Dorado Hills, ending with a Folsom Pointe BBQ with music and KCRA’s Tamera Berg as Mistress of Ceremonies; and


