



## RESOLUTION NO. 115-2023

## OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF EL DORADO

WHEREAS, the Sheriff in his capacity as the El Dorado County Director of Emergency Services, did proclaim the existence of a Local Emergency on September 9, 2022, based on the conditions relating to the Mosquito Fire; and

WHEREAS, the County Health Officer did proclaim the existence of a Local Health Emergency on September 9, 2022, based on conditions relating to the Mosquito Fire; and

WHEREAS, the El Dorado County Board of Supervisors did find at its regularly scheduled meeting on September 13, 2022 that the aforesaid conditions did warrant and necessitate the recertifications of the Local Emergency and the Local Health Emergency via Resolutions Nos. 142-2022 and 143-2022 respectively; and

WHEREAS, the Sheriff and the Health Officer both agree the emergency proclamations are not necessary at this time,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that said Local Emergency and Local Health Emergency shall be terminated.
