Background



Draft contract amendment prepared to address state law updates. Draft amendment presented to the Board on July 23, 2024

Board adopted interim community design standards

February 2022

August 2022

September 2022 – April 2024

December 2024

Work paused due to updates to state law Board direction to pause the draft amendment and:


- 1) Develop Countywide interim objective community design standards

Revised Scope of Work




- Added Rural Center community design standards (Component 4)
- Added section for project management and County coordination (Component 3)
- Removed CEQA compliance review (staff to handle)
- Removed community outreach/engagement (staff to handle)
- Removed extra Board and Commission study sessions (Board and Commission public workshops still included in planned work)



Optional Tasks & Component



- Remove optional tasks \$61,291.42 cost savings:
 - Board workshops (Tasks 1.6, 2.7, and 4.6)
 - Additional architectural styles
 - Remove two styles (Task 1.4)
 - Remove one style (Task 2.3)
- Keep optional Component 4 (Rural Centers) \$176,930
- Keep one additional architectural style (Task 2.3) \$11,950





Staff Recommendation



- Approve and authorize the Chair to sign Amendment 2 to Agreement 5912, including the revised Scope of Work and Cost Estimates (Exhibits A-1 and C-1);
- Reduce the contract budget by \$61,291.42 to reflect savings recommended by staff through removal of optional tasks, for a total cost of \$645,954.42
- Extend the term of the agreement by 3 years with a new expiration date of August 1, 2028
