DR22-0002 - Tumble Time II (DG Granade, Inc./Joseph Nielsen & Dave Ochoa/Jon N. Westphal): A Design Review Permit request for a proposed 15,000-square foot commercial building including 12,400-square feet of gym floor, and an 800-square foot dance studio, for the purpose of leasing the building to an existing gymnastics instruction facility.
