Subject: 2024 Tahoe Truckee Sierra Disposal Interim Year Rate Analysis for Rates Effective July 1, 2023 – Draft Report

Crowe LLP (Crowe) has completed its analysis of Tahoe Truckee Sierra Disposal's (TTSD) 2024 Interim Year Rate Application (Application). El Dorado County (County) contracted with Crowe to conduct an analysis of the Application and to provide potential refuse collection rate changes for the County to consider effective July 1, 2023. This letter report is organized as follows:

A. Purpose of Analysis

The purpose of the 2024 Interim Year Rate Analysis of TTSD (Analysis) is to assist the County with establishing solid waste collection rates charged by TTSD. The Analysis was conducted in accordance with the County's *Solid Waste Rate Setting Policies and Procedures Manual for Unincorporated Areas* (Rate Manual), incorporated into the Tahoe Truckee Sierra Disposal Franchise Agreement, approved by the County Board of Supervisors on October 27, 2015.

In the course of preparing this Analysis, we have not conducted an audit, review, or compilation of any financial or supplemental data. We have made certain projections of revenues and expenses which may vary from actual results because events and circumstances frequently do not occur as expected and such variances may be material. We have no responsibility to update this Analysis for events or circumstances occurring after the date above.

Our procedures and work product are intended for the benefit and use of the County. This engagement was not planned or conducted in contemplation of reliance by any other party or with respect to any specific transaction and is not intended to benefit or influence any other party. Therefore, items of possible interest to a third party may not be specifically addressed or matters may exist that could be assessed differently by a third party.

This Analysis is substantially different from an audit, examination, or review in accordance with Generally Accepted Auditing Standards, the objective of which is to express an opinion regarding TTSD financial statements. Accordingly, we do not express such an opinion. Crowe's services and work product were performed in accordance with the Standards for Consulting Services established by the American

Institute of Certified Public Accountants ("AICPA") and do not constitute an audit, examination, or review in accordance with standards established by the AICPA.

In the preparation of this Analysis, Crowe relied upon the information provided to Crowe without verification or investigation. The information in this Analysis is based on estimates, assumptions and other data developed by Crowe from information provided by TTSD, knowledge of and participation in other studies, data supplied by the County, and other sources deemed to be reliable.

Crowe worked at the direction of the County in providing our services and preparing this Analysis. The County determined and approved the scope included within Crowe's work. The County will review this report and will determine to accept this Analysis and how to implement the results of Crowe's services.

The consulting services did not contemplate obtaining the understanding of TTSD internal controls or assessing control risks, tests of accounting records and responses to inquiries by obtaining corroborating evidential matter, and certain other procedures ordinarily performed during an audit, examination, or review. Thus, this engagement was not intended to provide assurance that we would become aware of significant matters that would be disclosed in an audit, examination, or review.

The County agreed to be responsible to make all management decisions and perform all management functions; designate an individual who possesses suitable skill, knowledge, and/or experience, preferably within senior management to oversee these services; evaluated the adequacy and results of the services performed; and accepted responsibility for the results of the services.

Crowe's fees are not dependent upon the outcome of this report and Crowe is independent with respect to any other economic interests.

B. Summary

Our Analysis supports a rate increase of 5.19 percent for the El Dorado West Shore area, effective July 1, 2023. Current 2023 and calculated 2024 residential rates, for selected service levels, are shown in **Table 1.** Current 2023 and calculated 2024 commercial rates, for selected service levels, are shown in **Table 2**. The comprehensive 2023-24 rate structure is provided in **Attachment A** of this report.

C. Background of Analysis

The County is responsible for overseeing solid waste and coordinating solid waste program planning and reporting. In 2015, the County prepared the Rate Manual, which guides rate setting for the unincorporated areas of the County served by TTSD (including Meeks Bay and Tahoma).

The County followed the Interim Year Rate Setting Process in Section 3 of the Rate Manual for the interim rate year 2024. The Rate Manual allows TTSD to submit an interim year rate application for the rate year 2024. Our Analysis was conducted in accordance with Steps 1 and 2 in Section 3 of the Rate Manual.¹ Recently approved rate changes are as follows²:

- 2012 5.00 percent rate increase
- 2013 1.00 percent rate increase
- 2014 No rate adjustment
- 2015 1.52 percent rate increase base year
- 2016 1.75 percent rate increase interim year
- 2017 1.51 percent rate increase interim year
- 2018 1.92 percent rate increase base year
- 2019 6.00 percent rate increase interim year
- 2020 1.00 percent rate increase interim year
- 2021 7.43 percent rate increase base year
- 2022 4.72 percent rate increase interim year.

On May 22, 2023, TTSD submitted an Application (**Attachment B**) to the County requesting to increase collection rates by 5.19 percent, effective July 1, 2023.³ Crowe has reviewed TTSD's Application and found it consistent with the requirements set forth in the approved Rate Manual.

¹ The County allows for the franchise hauler to submit an interim year rate application in each of the "interim" two (2) years between "base" years, should the franchised hauler want to request an increase in rates.

² Formal rate setting was incorporated into the County's franchise agreement with TTSD in 2015. Rate changes prior to 2015 were included in this report for historical purposes.

³ TTSD initially submitted an application to the County requesting a rate increase of 5.36 percent, but subsequently provided an updated application reducing the requested rate increase from 5.36 percent to 5.19 percent after Crowe identified an error in the tipping fee increase portion of the Application.

In its Application, TTSD projected increases in 2024 landfill disposal costs of negative 0.83 percent and increases in 2024 non-landfill disposal costs of 5.21 percent. TTSD defined its total change in disposal costs, negative 0.83 percent, as the sum of the year-over-year change in transfer station tipping fees, negative 2.803 percent, and year-over-year change in disposal tons, 2.03 percent.⁴ Non-landfill disposal costs of 5.21 percent represent 85 percent of the percent change in the Consumer Price Index from December 2021 to December 2022.⁵ Based on actual results from the most recent Base Year, TTSD indicated that landfill disposal costs represent 4.60 percent of total costs, while non-landfill disposal costs represent 95.40 percent of total costs. After incorporating a 5 percent franchise fee, TTSD requested a weighted percent increase in rates of 5.19 percent in its Application.

D. Scope of Analysis

Our scope of services included the following tasks:

- Identify applicable Consumer Price Index (U.S. Garbage and Trash)
- Request additional data and clarification from TTSD
- Determine new rates
- Prepare the draft report
- Receive comments on the draft report
- Prepare the final report.

For this Analysis, we performed the following tasks:

- Assessed if the Application was mathematically accurate and logically consistent
- Verified that the Application complied with the terms and conditions of the Rate Manual
- Assessed supporting data and documentation
- Prepared the draft and final reports
- Participated in County preparation and meeting(s), as required.

E. Results of Analysis

Crowe has evaluated TTSD's Application and rate increase request and has determined that a rate increase of 5.19 percent is consistent with the terms of the interim year rate setting procedures contained within the Rate Manual (see also **Attachment C** for the applicable CPI calculation used for the Analysis). A full rate schedule reflecting a 5.19 percent increase to collection rates is provided in **Attachment A**.

⁴ The 2.03 percent and negative 2.803 percent figures do not add up exactly to negative 0.83 percent due to rounding; they add up to negative 0.77 percent. The negative 0.83 percent figure can be calculated as Total Projected Interim Year Disposal Costs of \$35,295.57 divided by Total Prior Year Disposal Costs of \$35,590.80, minus one.

⁵ In accordance with the Rate Manual, the actual allowable rate increase is 85 percent of the percent change in CPI from December 2021 to December 2022 of 6.13 percent (see **Attachment C** for CPI calculation), which equals 5.21 percent (0.85 x 6.13 percent). Additionally, the total rate increase falls below the 6 percent rate cap identified on page 3-2 of the Rate Manual.
