



**RESOLUTION NO. 001-2011**

**OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF EL DORADO**

**Resolution to Authorize the Director of Transportation to Temporarily Close a Section of Green Valley Road and North Shingle Road and the North Access of Peaceful Garden Way for the Construction of the Green Valley Road at Tennessee Creek Bridge Replacement Project During the 2011/2012 Construction Seasons**

**WHEREAS**, the County plans to replace the Tennessee Creek Bridge on Green Valley Road and to construct other roadway improvements on Green Valley Road and North Shingle Road for Capital Improvement Project No. 77109 during the 2011/2012 construction seasons; and

**WHEREAS**, a new bridge, traffic signal, pavement, drainage culverts and waterline will be constructed as part of the Project; and

**WHEREAS**, in order to perform grading and to construct pavement at the intersection of North Shingle and Green Valley Roads and to facilitate construction staging for the new bridge, North Shingle Road, from Green Valley Road to approximately six hundred (600) feet south, and Green Valley Road, between Rose Springs Lane and Kenworth Drive/Oakvale Drive, will need to be closed for two (2), four-day (4-day) periods, from 9:00 p.m. Thursdays to 5:00 a.m. Tuesdays; and

**WHEREAS**, in order to perform grading and to reconstruct the encroachment pavement at one of the two access points of Peaceful Garden Way, a private road, to conform to roadway improvements along Green Valley Road, the north access to Peaceful Garden Way at Green Valley Road will need to be closed for five (5) days; and

**WHEREAS**, an alternate access route/detour will be available during the temporary closure and traffic will be directed by signage to this route/detour; and

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to California Vehicle Code Section 21101 (e), the Board of Supervisors is authorized to temporarily close a portion of any street for the safety and protection of persons who are to use that portion of the street during the temporary closing; and

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to California Vehicle Code Section 21101 (e) and California Streets and Highways Code Section 942.6, the Board of Supervisors may designate the Director of Transportation to determine the exact dates and times for the closures;


**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Director of Transportation is authorized to order the temporary closure of North Shingle Road, from Green Valley Road to approximately six hundred (600) feet south, and Green Valley Road, between Rose Springs Lane and Kenworth Drive/Oakvale Drive, for two (2), four-day (4-day) periods as described above, and the temporary closure of the north access to Peaceful Garden Way at Green Valley Road for five (5) days and to establish an alternate access routes/detours for traffic use during the time of temporary closures. The precise dates of the temporary road closures are to be determined by the Director of Transportation, with notification of the pending temporary road closures or detours to be provided to the County Supervisor of District 4, business owners, residents, the general public, the El Dorado County Transit Authority and to safety and law enforcement agencies in the Project area, through direct communications, signage, or flyers.


