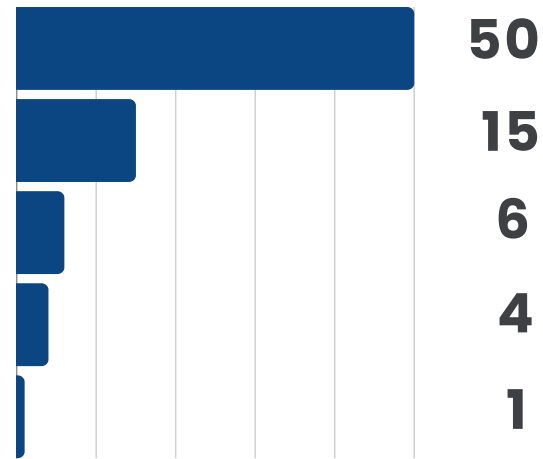

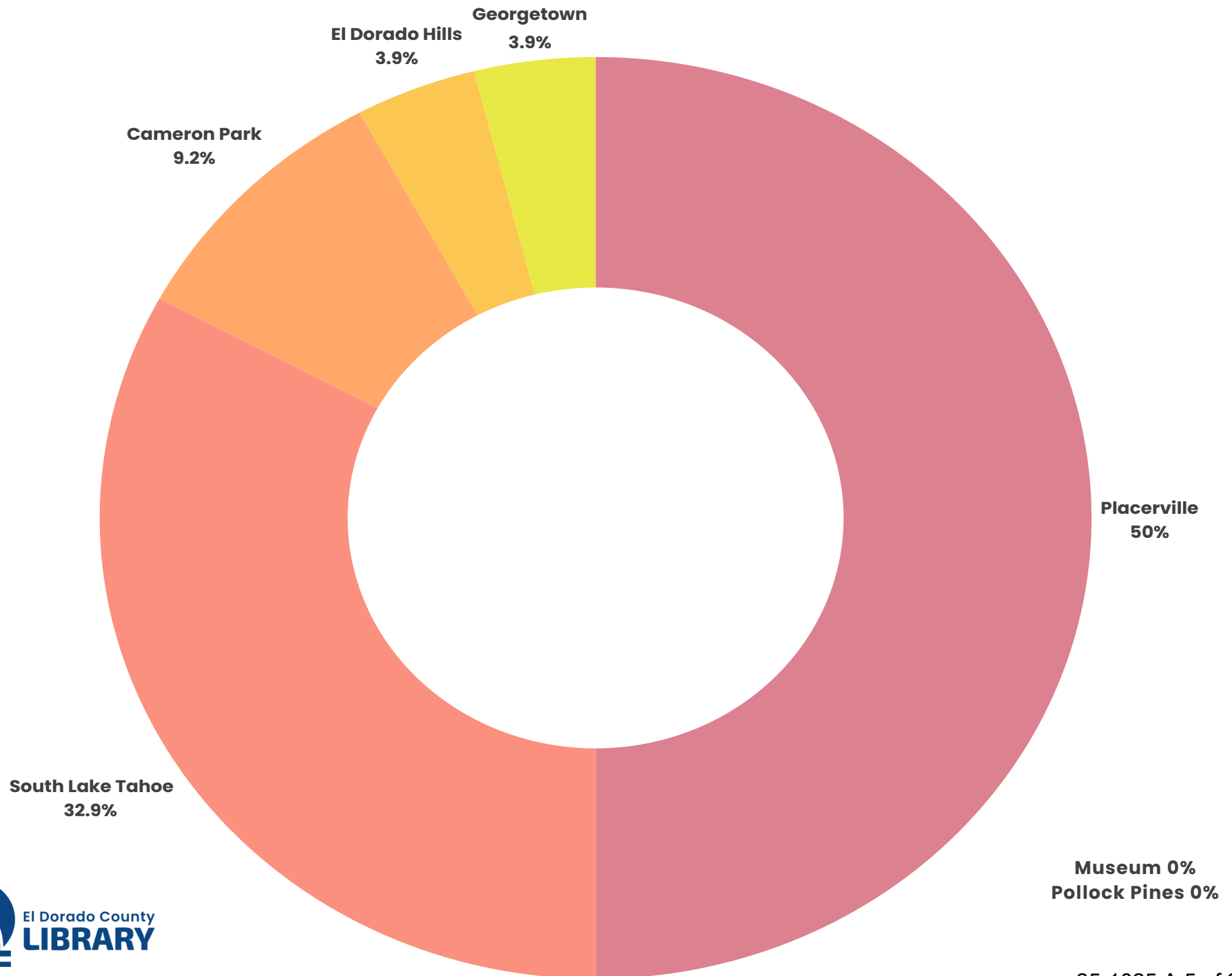

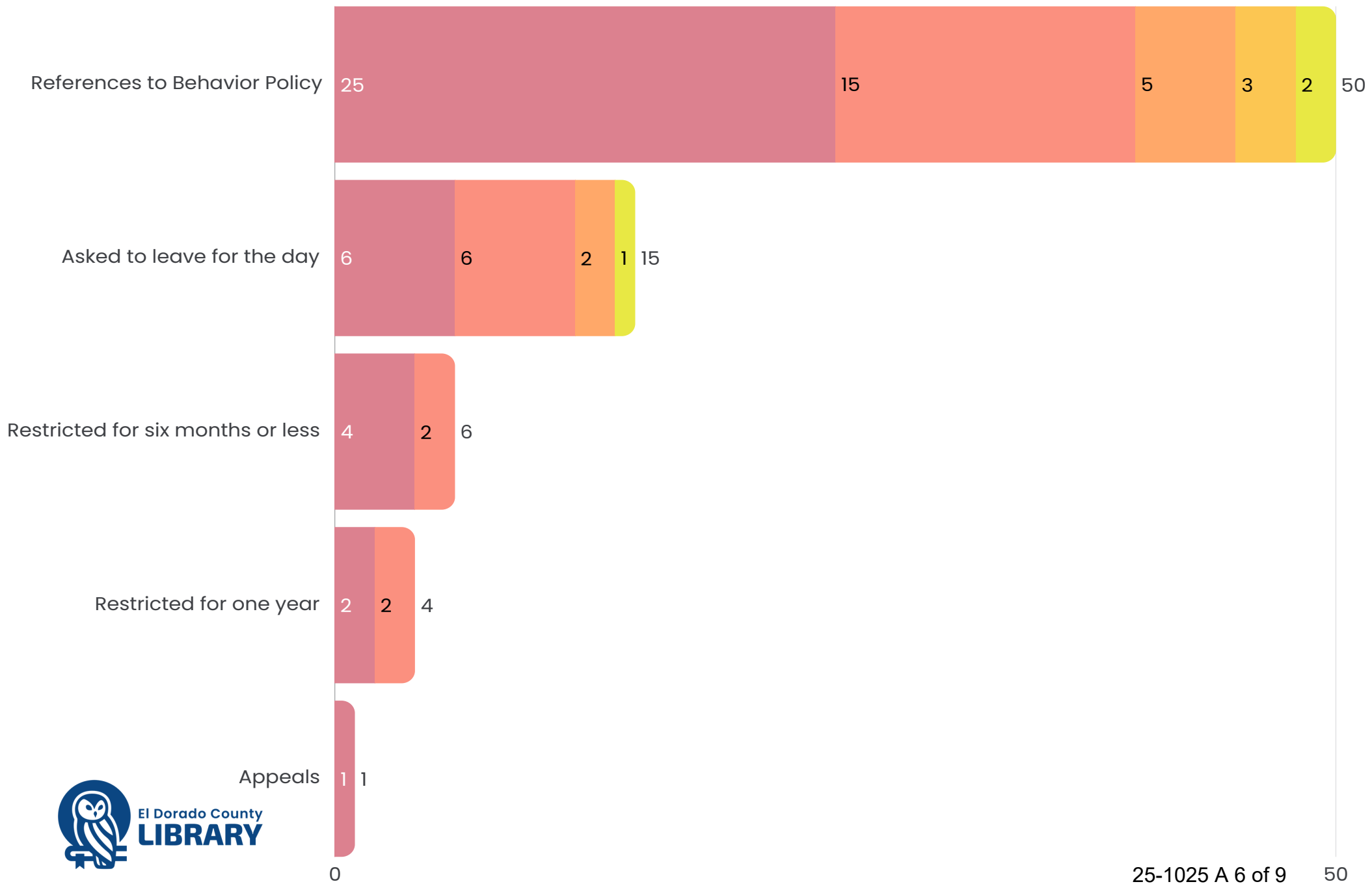


PERCENTAGE OF POLICY REFERENCES BY LOCATION
