To whom it may concern:

I currently work at Marshall Hematology and Oncology as the chemotherapy scheduler, as well as the phlebotomist/medical assistant. Although I have only had the privilege to work here 2 years, I see daily the significant impact we make on the patients and families that we serve in El Dorado County. Without our services patients would be traveling numerous miles and hours in traffic for doctor visits and necessary chemotherapy treatments. Chemotherapy alone is difficult, and many of the treatment regimens require concurrent days of treatment and supportive injections in an effort to ensure blood counts are not compromised. During treatment, the average chemotherapy patient comes to our clinic 2-3 times every other week, and to be able to do so locally is a huge blessing especially with high gas prices. On a more personal note, we are extremely limited in the services we are able to provide patients right now. We have 11 treatment chairs in which to treat patients, and on very busy days patients have to wait until a space is available. I recognize we have intentions of expanding, and I truly hope that we can. When a patient comes in for treatment it is valuable to have a family member or two included to make it less intimidating and overwhelming. Not only that but I heard we will ultimately have a healing garden, which would give patients, employees, and family members an amazing opportunity to grieve and heal during these difficult times.

Cancer touches so many lives in our community and it would be so helpful to have all cancer needs met under one roof. Patients are going through so much to begin with, and anything our community can do to make their road easier, should be done. I have grown to know and respect all of our patients; they have taught me so much about life and courage. It is my sincere hope that the Board of Supervisors will seriously consider financial assistance towards a Collaborative Comprehensive Cancer Center. One never knows when cancer services will be needed and to strategically apply tobacco funding to achieve placing all services in one location is definitely the right thing to do! Thank you for consideration of this plea in support of our community.
