**Resolution for Road Closure for the
“Pollock Pines 4th of July Parade”**

WHEREAS, The Pollock Pines Camino Rotary Club, (sponsors) desires to hold the Fourth of July Parade event on Monday, July 4, 2016; and

WHEREAS, said sponsors have applied for a Road Closure Permit pursuant to Vehicle Code 21101(e), Ordinance Code §12.37.010 et seq., and County Resolution 110-79 in order to promote the Fourth of July Parade Event on Monday, July 4, 2016; and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that a full road closure will be in effect for Pony Express Trail from Sly Park Road to Sanders Drive, with partial road closures at the intersections of Forebay Road, Oak Street, North Street, Polaris Street, Laurel Drive and Sanders Drive on Monday, July 4, 2016, between 11:30 a.m. and 2:00 p.m. for the “Pollock Pines 4th of July Parade,” subject to conditions set forth in Resolution No. 110-79 dated May 1, 1979, and conditions set forth in the “Application for Road Closure” submitted for this event.

This Resolution and the Application with conditions shall together constitute the Road Closure Permit.
