



RESOLUTION NO. 051-2026

OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF EL DORADO

**AMENDING RESOLUTION 120-2023 RELATED TO HEALTH AND HUMAN SERVICES AGENCY
PUBLIC HEALTH VITAL STATISTICS FEE SCHEDULE**

WHEREAS, the County of El Dorado (County) Board of Supervisors (Board) is authorized to adopt new fees, fee levels, and charges, pursuant to California Constitution Article XI, Section 11, Government Code Sections 54985 and 66018, and County Ordinance Code Section 1.04.260;

WHEREAS, on July 25, 2023, the Board adopted Resolution 120-2023 which established County's Public Health Clinic and Vital Statistics fees (Legistar File 23-0649);

WHEREAS, the Vital Statistic fees established under Resolution 120-2023 did not include a provision that clearly allows HHS's Public Health Division (PHD) to adjust the Vital Statistics fees to the amounts mandated by the State of California or its Departments (State), such as the California Department of Public Health, pursuant to state statute;

WHEREAS, to ensure that Vital Statistic fees can be adjusted by HHS PHD in the event that the State increases or decreases any of the fees pursuant to state statute or regulation, the amended Exhibit C, marked "Public Health Vital Statistics Fees" enables HHS PHD to adjust Vital Statistic fees in accordance with the State fees;

WHEREAS, in addition, the County birth certificate fee shall continue to include an additional \$3.00 to the state fee, the maximum local increase allowed by statute for deposit in the County's children's trust fund, as authorized under California Code, Health and Safety Code, Section 103625, and should the State increase the state imposed fee, the additional local increase of \$3.00 will continue to be included in any such fee adjustment such that the total birth certificate fee shall match the state imposed amount plus the additional \$3.00;

WHEREAS, the revised fees included in Exhibit C are the Birth Certificate, Death Certificate, and Fetal Death Certificate fees, reflective of the adjusted State imposed amounts, with the Birth Certificate fee inclusive of the additional \$3.00 for the maximum local fee allowed;

WHEREAS, the remaining fees in Exhibit C remain unchanged in amount and include both (1) County portions reasonably necessary to recover the County's costs of providing the products or services described, and (2) amounts mandated by the State pursuant to state statute;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that effective March 10, 2026, Board Resolution No. 120-2023 is hereby amended by this Resolution, and the Public Health Vital Statistics fees, fee levels, and charges attached hereto as Exhibit C, shall replace in its entirety Exhibit C of Resolution No. 120-2023 and be implemented.

Vital Statistic Fees not enumerated herein that are mandated by the State through statute or regulation shall be correspondingly established herein.

¹ This El Dorado County rate shall be increased or decreased automatically in accordance with any State of California imposed rate change as set forth in HSC 103625 (and any other applicable statutes) and shall continue to include the additional \$3.00 local amount as authorized under HSC 103625(b)(2) such that the rate shall total the state imposed amount plus an additional \$3.00.

² This El Dorado County rate shall be increased or decreased automatically in accordance with any mandated rate change pursuant to any State of California or Department of the State, such as the California Department of Health Services, statute or regulation.
