WHEREAS, The Georgetown Divide Recreation District (sponsor) desires to hold the “Garden Valley Annual 4th of July Parade and Celebration” on Friday, July 4, 2014; and

WHEREAS, said sponsors have applied for a Road Closure Permit pursuant to Vehicle Code 21102(e), Ordinance Code §12.37.010 et seq., and County Resolution 110-79 in order to promote the “Garden Valley Annual 4th of July Parade and Celebration” on Friday, July 4, 2014; and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that a road closure will be in effect for Marshall Road between Greenwood Road and Garden Valley Road on Friday, July 4, 2014 from 10:00 a.m. to 11:00 a.m., for the Garden Valley Annual 4th of July Parade and Celebration, subject to conditions set forth in Resolution No. 110-79 dated May 1, 1979, and subject to the conditions set forth in the Application for Road Closure, submitted for this event.

This Resolution and the Application with conditions shall together constitute the Road Closure Permit.
