



RESOLUTION NO. 019-2026

OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF EL DORADO

WHEREAS, Payrates must be reported to the California Public Employees' Retirement System (CalPERS) in accordance with Government Code Sections 20636 and 7522.34(a), as well as California Code of Regulations Title 2, Section 570.5; and

WHEREAS, California Code of Regulations Title 2, Section 570.5 requires the payrate to be limited to the amount listed on a pay schedule that meets the following requirements: (1) Has been duly approved and adopted by the employer's governing body in accordance with requirements of applicable public meetings laws; (2) Identifies the position title for every employee position; (3) Shows the payrate for each identified position, which may be stated as a single amount or as multiple amounts within a range; (4) Indicates the time base, including, but not limited to, whether the time base is hourly, daily, bi-weekly, monthly, bi-monthly, or annually; (5) Is posted at the office of the employer or immediately accessible and available for public review from the employer during normal business hours or posted on the employer's internet website; (6) Indicates an effective date and date of any revisions; (7) Is retained by the employer and available for public inspection for not less than five years; and (8) Does not reference another document in lieu of disclosing the payrate; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors have approved, through resolutions, changes to the salary schedule for the 2025 calendar year; and

WHEREAS, as the result of a CalPERS audit, CalPERS has directed the County to retroactively adopt the salary schedule for each calendar year.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, the Board of Supervisors of the County of El Dorado authorizes the Director of Human Resources to make any technical corrections if needed.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Board of Supervisors of the County of El Dorado does hereby retroactively adopt the County's 2025 salary schedule as shown in Attachment C, with the revisions to the salary schedule contained therein identified in Attachment D and effective as of the date stated in Attachment D for each revision.
