

By-Laws

El Dorado County Community Action Council

Current By-Laws

Name: Community Action Council, Incorporated

Term of Office: Representation by Public Officials shall be determined annually prior to March 1st by the designating officials.

Low-Income Sector and Community Sector shall serve on the Council for two (2) years.

Limitation on Council Service: Representatives of the Low-Income and Public Official Sector may serve up to five (5) consecutive terms, not for no more than ten (10) years.

Officers: All Officers shall be elected annually by a majority vote of Council Members, representatives or alternates.

Elections are held in the month of April, to take effect in the month of May.

Proposed By-Laws

Name: Community Action Council

Term of Office: Representatives of the Public Official Sector shall be conterminous with the elected terms.

Low-Income Sector and Community Sector shall serve on the Council for four (4) years.

Limitation on Council Service: Representatives of the Low-Income and Public Official Sector may serve up to five (5) consecutive terms, no more than twenty (20) years.

Officers: Elected Officers shall hold office for a maximum of three (3) terms. Each term is one (1) year in duration.

The Officers will be elected in May and take office at the subsequent meeting.
