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Hello Supervisors and Clerk of the Board,

This agenda item is requesting a new CIP project number for Silva Valley/ Appian Way intersection, however there are no supporting details or description of what the project entails.

We know that projects are added due to critical deficiencies, but typically that is supported by a traffic study. Alternatively it could be due to a safety, but that also is typically supported by accident reports, etc. None of this is included in any of the documents, including the staff presentation. The amount of \$2.6M had to have a basis for estimation, so it would help to know the estimated work to be accomplished and why it is now be added.

There has been no discussion for expansion of Silva Valley to 4 lanes between Harvard and Green Valley, although there is an unfunded CIP project for that (36105037). Will this new CIP have to be reworked if that roadway expansion ever occurs?

Second item on this request is "deletion" of EDH Blvd. overlay (CIP 36105049). It speaks of only the overlay, but below is the description of this project from the current CIP Book. The project total estimate is \$6.2M. Has all the rest of this been accomplished, or should we just remove the overlay funding and keep the remainder in "Unfunded" so we do not lost sight of it?

Road surface overlay on El Dorado Hills Blvd (EDHB) from Saratoga Way/Park Drive to Harvard Way. Install Class II bike lanes along portions of the project limits on EDHB. Improve pedestrian ramps to ADA standards at all intersections along EDHB. Make bicycle and pedestrian loop detection improvements at all intersections along EDHB.

This item is a great example of why public engagement per topic should be opened again, because if this is only part of the staff discussion, then we have no ability to respond based on current information.

First, can you please explain why Item 3, "Remove El Dorado Hills Blvd Overlay – Saratoga to Harvard Way, CIP 36105049," is being removed?

We support both existing and new businesses in El Dorado Hills, as I am sure you do. At the same time, traffic on the south side of Highway 50 is becoming increasingly serious concern for businesses, residents, and the broader community.

The road improvement information in the attached Legistar item is difficult to follow, so I would appreciate clarification on the following:

1. What is the current completion date for widening Latrobe Road from Post Street to the Silva Valley Interchange?
2. In light of the additional traffic expected from the pending Costco project, what is the completion date for widening Latrobe Road and White Rock Road?
