



RESOLUTION NO. 081-2026

OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF EL DORADO

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE AUDITOR-CONTROLLER TO DRAW A NEW WARRANT REPLACING WARRANTS VOIDED UNDER THE PROVISIONS OF GOVERNMENT CODE SECTION 29802

WHEREAS, Government Code Section 29802 (a) provides that any warrant issued is void if not presented to the county treasurer for payment within six months after its date of issue;

WHEREAS, Government Code Section 29802 (b) provides that the Board of Supervisors may by resolution authorize the auditor to draw new warrants within the limitations prescribed by the resolution without prior individual order by the Board of Supervisors for warrants presented any time within two years from the date on which the original warrant became void;

WHEREAS, Government Code Section 29802 (c) provides that the Board of Supervisors may by resolution authorize the auditor to draw new warrants within the limitations prescribed by the resolution without prior individual order by the order of Board of Supervisors for warrants presented any time after a period of two years from the date on which the original warrant became void in any case in which the auditor determines that it would be inequitable or unreasonable not to draw the warrant.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors of the County of El Dorado, State of California, as follows:

1. The Board of Supervisors authorizes the Auditor-Controller to draw new warrants for all uncashed void warrants that are presented, or for which affidavits of loss or destruction are presented, within two years from the date on which the original warrant became void, without prior individual order by the Board of Supervisors.
2. The Board of Supervisors authorizes the Auditor-Controller to draw new warrants for uncashed void warrants not exceeding \$10,000 that are presented more than two years from the date on which the original warrant became void in any case in which the Auditor-Controller determines that it would be inequitable or unreasonable not to draw the warrant and money is available in the County Treasury to make payment on the indebtedness, without prior individual order by the Board of Supervisors.
