



RESOLUTION NO. 076-2017

OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF EL DORADO

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Supervisors of the County of El Dorado conducted a hearing on the appropriations limit for El Dorado County on June 7, 2016;

**WHEREAS**, the hearing was advertised and noticed as required by law: and,

**WHEREAS**, the Board received testimony and other evidence regarding the appropriation limitation to be established for El Dorado County; and,

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Board of Supervisors of the County of El Dorado that the El Dorado County appropriations limit for the 2016-2017 fiscal year, as described in Article XIII B of the State Constitution and implemented by Chapter 1205, Statutes of 1980 is the sum of \$195,598,999 computed as follows:

2016-2017 Increase in the California per capita personal income is 5.37% or the factor of 1.0537;  
2016-2017 Increase in Population is 0.56% or the factor of 1.0056;  
1.0537 (X) 1.0056 = 1.0596 is the combined factor for increasing the 2015-2016 appropriation limitation.

Limit Established for FY 2015-2016:	\$184,597,017
Growth Factor FY 2016-2017:	<u>1.0596</u>
Limit for FY 2016-2017:	\$195,598,999
