Dear Supervisor Veerkamp;

I am writing to let you know that I am supportive of the placement of a cell tower in the vicinity of Victory Mine Road (known as the Tiger Lily tower). As I understand, this tower complies with the County's requirements in regards to safety, health concerns and visual quality. I am a resident in the area (located off of Oak Hill Road) and have been extremely frustrated with the poor quality of cell signal and the lack of internet access in our area. AT&T has moved away from supporting DSL and other "landline" internet access. This tower will allow many of us along Oak Hill Road and surrounding area to have reasonable internet access and improved cell coverage. I appreciate that some residents have concerns regarding health risks associated with cell towers and the near-source electromagnetic waves. The county requirements for permitting of cell towers should be kept up to date with current health risk studies and that information should continue to be shared with the public, so that the local property owners and residents can feel safe being located near a cell tower. I encourage you and the other Supervisors to approve the permit for this tower. Thank you very much.
