Program Requirements

Project Description:

The El Dorado County Environmental Management Department (EMD) operates a litter abatement crew. The purpose of the crew is to remove discarded debris from along the roadways and respond to complaints of illegal dump sites throughout the County. EMD will apply City-County Payment Program funds to funding roadside litter abatement. These funds are only applied to roadside litter abatement that reliably contains bottles and cans.

EMD would also like to start an Adopt-A-Roadway program for the roadside litter abatement on El Dorado County Roadways. If EMD adopts this program, EMD plans to post "Adopt-A-Roadway" signs to promote the program and the businesses, non- profits, etc. that have adopted the roadway. If the program is implemented, EMD plans to use City-County Payment Program funds to have the signs made and installed along adopted roadways recognizing participants.

Other City-County Payment Program funds will be used for the purchase of recycling receptacles for placement throughout the county. EMD's Recycling Container Program (RCP) allows the placement of beverage container recycling receptacles at select fuel stations throughout the County. Fuel stations are selected through EMD compliance history, proximity to major freeways/roads, and those stations agreeing to participate in the RCP guidelines. EMD also plans on purchasing more recycling receptacles that will be located in areas frequented by the public (parks, city/town hubs, marinas, campgrounds, etc.) and/or on school campuses.
