OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF EL DORADO  
Proclaiming the Month of October 2009  
**80<sup>th</sup> ANNIVERSARY CELEBRATION OF THE PLACERVILLE AIRPORT**

**Whereas**, on March 20, 1929 the first airplane landed at Placerville Airport; and

**Whereas**, on November 13, 1929 a Stearman bi-plane was the first airplane to land at Placerville Airport for the purpose of providing transportation; and

**Whereas**, California has become a recognized leader in the aviation and aerospace industries and is the home of many firsts in aviation, home to many world renowned air and space pioneers, and home for numerous aviation and aerospace companies and concerns; and

**Whereas**, aviation is a vitally important economic engine and transportation source which connects El Dorado County to California's and the nation's global markets; and

**Whereas**, education and public awareness programs will foster improved relations between the public and aviation and aerospace industries; provide a foundation for the training of individuals to meet future personnel requirements of the industries and promote a greater understanding of the important role which aviation and aerospace plays in our lives; and

**Whereas**, the future of aviation is dependent upon a well-informed and educated populace, and this celebration of powered flight is also the celebration of the ingenuity and creativity of Americans, as well as America's contribution to air and space flight; and

**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED**, that the El Dorado County Board of Supervisors does hereby proclaim the month of October 2009 as the **80<sup>TH</sup> ANNIVERSARY OF THE PLACERVILLE AIRPORT** in El Dorado County, California.
