DESCRIPTION OF THE PROJECT The work to be done is shown on the Plans, and generally consists of, but is not limited to the following: Construct fills and perform grading, paving, striping and signage work required to widen and realign Latrobe Road to four lanes plus a median within the limits described on the plans. Install signalization at the intersection of Latrobe Road and Golden Foothill Parkway (Entrance #3). Modify existing signalization at the intersection of Latrobe Road and Suncastr Lane. Construct new asphalt concrete dike and drains. Provide temporary and permanent erosion control. Modify existing and construct new drainage facilities. Construct new prestressed concrete box girder bridge at Carson Creek. Other items or details not mentioned above, that are required by the Plans, Standard Specifications, or these Special Provisions, shall be performed, constructed or installed.		
LOCATION OF PROJECT: This Project is located on Latrobe Road south of and including the Suncastr Lane intersection to south of the Golden Foothill Parkway intersection and on Latrobe Road south of the Investment Blvd. intersection in El Dorado County.
