COUNTY OF EL DORADO, ROAD 3-ED-49-PM 11.8/11.9

WHEREAS, highway right of way in the townsite of  
Diamond Springs, County of El Dorado, from approximately 213 feet  
west of the existing intersection of State Route 49 and Pleasant  
Valley Road to 525 feet north of the existing intersection of  
State Route 49 and Pleasant Valley Road and 256 feet east of the  
existing intersection of State Route 49 and Pleasant Valley Road,  
road 3-ED-49, hereinafter particularly described, has been  
superseded by a change in the location of said highway; and

WHEREAS, by Cooperative Agreement dated May 23, 2000,  
and by Amendment No. 1 to Agreement dated December 19, 2006,  
between the County of El Dorado and the State of California, the  
County waived the 90-day notice requirement and agreed to accept  
title to said superseded highway, upon relinquishment thereof to  
said County by the State of California; and

WHEREAS, this Commission has found and determined, and does hereby find and determine, that it is desirable and in the public interest that said highway right of way so superseded be relinquished to the County of El Dorado for use as county highway(s);


NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS VOTED by the California Transportation Commission that it relinquish, and it does hereby relinquish, to the County of El Dorado, effective upon the recordation of a certified copy hereof with the Recorder of El Dorado County, all of the State of California's right, title and interest in and to said superseded highway right of way in said County, together with the right of way and appurtenances thereof, described as follows:

All that portion of superseded highway located in the County of El Dorado, State of California, as indicated by hatching and designated as "SEGMENT No. 1 TO BE RELINQUISHED" on that certain highway map recorded on November 1, 2007, in State Highway Map Book No. 3, pages 87 and 88, records of El Dorado County.

EXCEPTING AND RESERVING to the State of California any and all rights of ingress to and egress from the Highway hereby relinquished in and to the adjacent and adjoining State Route 49, except at such points as are now or may be established by resolution of this Commission.
