El Dorado County Air Quality Management District
AB 2588 Air Toxics "Hotspots" Public Hearing**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the El Dorado County Air Quality Management District (EDCAQMD) has scheduled a public hearing on July 16, 2024, at the El Dorado County Board of Supervisor's Hearing Room, 330 Fair Lane, Placerville, California, at 9AM or thereafter.

The Air Toxics "Hot Spots" Information and Assessment Act of 1987 (AB 2588) is a California public right-to-know law. Local air quality management and air pollution control districts must collect information about the location, type, and quantity of toxic compounds emitted into the air by specified local businesses and industries. The California Health and Safety Code (HSC section 44363 requires the air districts to prepare and publish an annual report that describes the priorities and categories of the permitted facilities, summarizes the results of health risk assessments, ranks and identifies facilities according to the degree of cancer risk posed to the public, identifies facilities which expose the public to noncancer health risks, and describes the status of the development of control measures to reduce emissions of toxic air contaminants. Per HSC section 44363(b), the Air District Board is required to hold one or more public hearings to present the report and discuss its content and significance.

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN that all interested persons may examine or request a copy of the EDCAQMD AB 2588 report and associated documents at the EDCAQMD office at 330 Fair Lane, Building A, Placerville, CA 95667 from 8:00 AM to 5:00 PM Monday through Friday, by advance appointment. Copies of this notice and the report are posted on the EDCAQMD website (www.eldoradocounty.ca.gov/Land-Use/Air-Quality-Management-District).
