Section 1. Section 3.30.020 of the El Dorado County Ordinance Code entitled "Written Report" is hereby amended as follows:

Sec. 3.30.020. Written Annual report.

- A. ~~Once a year the County Administrative Officer or his or her designee, after meeting and consulting with the County Service Area or Zone of Benefit Advisory Committee where appropriate, The County Department that is responsible for administering the particular Zone of Benefit program funded by a charge, shall annually~~ shall prepare and submit to the Board of Supervisors a written report. ~~That report which~~ shall contain a description of each parcel of real property receiving the particular extended service and the amount of the charge for each parcel for such year computed in conformity with the procedure set forth in this chapter authorizing collection of such charges on the tax roll. ~~Such report shall be filed with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors.~~
- B. ~~The County Department that prepares the annual report~~ under Subsection A shall present that report to the Board of Supervisors at a regular meeting. The Board may confirm the receipt of that report.

Section 2. Section ~~3.30.030~~ of the El Dorado County Ordinance Code entitled "Notice and hearing, protest, adoption of change" is hereby amended in its entirety to read as follows:
