

Proclamation

of the County of El Dorado Board of Supervisors Recognizing 2011 Union Mine High School Girls "Lady Diamondbacks" Volleyball Team

WHEREAS, on December 3, 2011, the Union Mine High School "Lady Diamondbacks" Girls Volleyball Team made history when they won the 2011 California Interscholastic Federation Division IV State Volleyball Championship; and

WHEREAS, in winning the State Championship, the Lady Diamondbacks heat the odds and achieved a 3-1 victory to triumph over the two-time California Division IV State Champion, San Diego La Jolla Country Day High School "Torrey" Girls Volleyball Team; and

WHEREAS, determined to make it to the State Championships, the Lady Diamondbacks dedicated countless personal hours throughout the offseason, to ultimately win the State Championship as part of their successful 33-5 record 2011 season; and

WHEREAS, in winning the 2011 State Championship, the Lady Diamondback team comprised of Andrea Barnes, Jordan Buxton, Maddy Berridge, Malia Gonzales, Lea Howton, Amy Pedretti, Sarah Phillis, Ashley Reese, Savanah Rye, Jacqueline Swarbrick, and Mikayla Tucker was also the first school from the region in fifteen years to win a state championship in volleyball and only the second team overall; and

WHEREAS, the Union Mine High School Girls Volleyball team was victorious under the leadership of Head Coach Mike Yates and Assistant Coach Kacee Del Rio; and

WHEREAS, Union Mine High School and the Lady Diamondbacks recognizes that such an accomplishment is achieved only through the personal dedication of each individual player, and coach, as well as their individual commitment to the success of the team, and that this dedication and commitment is made possible with the support of the players' parents, the residents and the surrounding businesses.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT PROCLAIMED, the County of El Dorado Board of Supervisors does herewith acknowledge the extraordinary accomplishments of the Union Mine High School Girls Volleyball Team for their 2011 California Interscholastic Federation Division IV State Title, and the honor and notoriety it brings to the El Dorado Unified School District and Union Mine High School, and does hereby take pride in approving this proclamation as evidence of their achievement.
