between the County of El Dorado, This Agreement is made this hereinafter referred to as "COUNTY" and El Dorado Union High School District, hereinafter referred to as the "CLIENT".

DESCRIPTION OF PROPERTY

1. The purpose of this Agreement is to state the terms and conditions under which the COUNTY will furnish supplemental law enforcement services to CLIENT. The premises where such services are to be provided are: Ponderosa High School, Oak Ridge High School, Union Mine High School and Independence High School, hereinafter referred to as the "PROTECTED PROPERTY".

PURPOSE OF AGREEMENT

2. The COUNTY will, as staffing levels permit, furnish supplemental enforcement security for Athletic and School Events as follows: various dates between when Agreement is fully executed and over the period when signed to June 30, 2025, as mutually agreed in writing between authorized representative of the parties in advance of each such event, with service levels for each event

RIGHT OF ENTRY

3. CLIENT hereby authorizes COUNTY to enter the PROTECTED PROPERTY described hereinabove whenever necessary in order to fulfill the provisions of Paragraph 2 hereinabove.

COMPENSATION

4. For the services herein agreed to be performed, the CLIENT shall pay the COUNTY the sum of Ninety-Five Dollars and Fifty Cents (\$95.50) per hour per Deputy Sheriff, One Hundred and Eighteen Dollars and eighty-four cents (\$118.84) per hour per Sergeant which includes travel time.

CLIENT shall pay COUNTY in full the cost after the COUNTY provides the services described in Paragraph 2 hereinabove.

UNIFORMS AND EQUIPMENT

5. While on duty at the PROTECTED PROPERTY, each officer shall be completely outfitted in his/her official uniform, badge, and other equipment normally worn by said officers during their normal course of duty.

SUPERVISION

6. At all times during the performance of this Agreement, officer(s) providing supplemental law enforcement services pursuant to this Agreement

shall be under the direct supervision and control of the Sheriff of El Dorado County and his designated subordinates. In the event of an emergency situation with the County of El Dorado, the Sheriff and/or his subordinates shall have the right to dispatch any or all officers performing services under this contract to the scene of the emergency.

EMPLOYEE OF THE COUNTY

7. All officers furnished by the COUNTY pursuant to this Agreement shall be employees of the COUNTY. The COUNTY will have the sole responsibility of paying the salary, taxes (including, but not limited to, federal social security taxes and federal and California unemployment taxes) and all other expenses relating to each employee of the COUNTY. The COUNTY shall further furnish and keep in full force and effect workers' compensation insurance covering all employees of the COUNTY engaged in performing the services required by this Agreement.

<u>TERMINATION</u>

8. Either party may terminate this Agreement at any time by giving ---7--day(s) written notice to the other party. In the event such services are
terminated, payment shall be made for all hours worked by COUNTY employees
up to the time of effective termination.

TERMINATION AND HOLD-HARMLESS AGREEMENT

9. The CLIENT hereby releases the COUNTY from any and all liability for

personal injury or property damage arising out of the use of the officers of the

COUNTY on the PROTECTED PROPERTY and agrees to hold the COUNTY free,

clear and harmless from any and all claims and demands whatsoever for personal

injury or property damage arising out of such use of officers of the COUNTY,

unless such injury or property damage is a result of the negligence of the

COUNTY or it's employees.

GOVERNING LAW, ENTIRETY OF AGREEMENT

AND PARTIAL INVALIDITY

This Agreement shall be governed by the laws of the State of 10.

California. It constitutes the entire agreement between the parties regarding its

subject matter. If any provision in this Agreement is held by any Court to be

invalid, void or unenforceable, the remaining provisions shall nevertheless

continue in full force.
