



RESOLUTION NO.

OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF EL DORADO

WHEREAS, representatives of the County of El Dorado and representatives of the Deputy Sheriffs' Association (Association) representing the Law Enforcement (SA) bargaining unit (collectively, the Parties), have met and negotiated in good faith since July 6, 2023; and

WHEREAS, said representatives have reached an agreement on a variety of terms and conditions of employment for employees in the SA bargaining unit to be incorporated as the successor Memorandum of Understanding for the period covering December 10, 2024 through December 9, 2026; and

WHEREAS, members of the Association representing employees in the SA bargaining unit have held election(s) and voted to ratify the negotiated terms and conditions contained within the tentative agreement for the successor Memorandum of Understanding; and,

WHEREAS, the previous Memorandum of Understanding between the Parties expired December 31, 2016, and the Parties are now bringing the negotiated and fully executed successor Memorandum of Understanding that is attached and incorporated herein to the Board of Supervisors for final approval.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board of Supervisors of the County of El Dorado approves, adopts, and authorizes the Chair to sign this Resolution and the successor Memorandum of Understanding that is attached and incorporated herein between the County of El Dorado and the Deputy Sheriffs' Association, representing the Law Enforcement bargaining unit, for the period of December 10, 2024, through December 9, 2026.
