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RESOLUTION No. 34-81

OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF EL DORADO

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors of El Dorado County has determined that the South Fork of the American River is a vital resource to the people of El Dorado County; and

WHEREAS, the corridor of the South Fork of the American River offers many opportunities for diversified uses, including recreation, mineral resources, hydroelectric generation, fish and wildlife habitats, and historical and educational values that may be enhanced by proper management techniques; and

WHEREAS, the total numbers of persons now utilizing the South Fork of the American River for whitewater rafting may be exceeding the environmental and social carrying capacity of the river corridor; and

WHEREAS, the El Dorado County Board of Supervisors has adopted Ordinance No. 3017 that regulates rafting on the South Fork of the American River, and

WHEREAS, the Interim Management Plan for the Streams and Rivers of El Dorado County offers a valid and reasonable procedure to manage whitewater rafting on the South Fork of the American River,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the El Dorado County Board of Supervisors adopts the Interim Management Plan for the Streams and Rivers of El Dorado County which is attached hereto as Exhibit "A" and incorporated herein by reference; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that in addition to those rules provided for in the Interim Management Plan, the Board of Supervisors, pursuant to

Ordinance No. 3017, hereby adopts the additional regulations as follows:

1) River Use Permit Fees: Each commercial operator shall, as an integral part of the Annual River Use Permit Application, submit a non-refundable filing fee of \$300.00 (Three Hundred Dollars). Where the River Use Permit is granted by the Board of Supervisors, each commercial operator is required to pay an additional River Use fee of \$1.00 (One Dollar) per passenger for each user-day upon the South Fork of the American River. River Use fee shall be due and payable for each commercial operator at the end of the month during the entire calendar year. The River Use fee shall be deposited in the Planning Department on or before the 7th day of each successive month of operation, together with the confirmed operating plan.

2) Liability Insurance: Each commercial operator shall, as an integral part of the River Use Permit Application, supply evidence of insurance, acceptable to the County for the following minimum amounts:

- A) General Liability and Property Damage \$ 25,000.
- B) Bodily Injury 500,000.
- C) Or Combined Single Limit 500,000.

Further, the policy must specifically name the County of El Dorado and the riparian land owners as co-insureds. The policy may not be cancelled without 30 days prior written notice to the County of El Dorado.
