



**RESOLUTION NO.  
OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF EL DORADO**

**RESOLUTION RESCINDING RESOLUTION NO. 417A-87, AND  
DISSOLVING THE BASSI ROAD CORRIDOR AREA OF BENEFIT**

**WHEREAS**, in 1987 the Board of Supervisors adopted resolution 417A-87 to form an Area of Benefit for the Bassi Road Corridor and set the fees therefore; and

**WHEREAS**, fees have been collected for the Bassi Road Corridor Area of Benefit; and

**WHEREAS**, over the last 20 years, the County has implemented various improvements to Bassi Road including a resurfacing project in 1992, an installation of an “All-Way” Stop Sign at the intersection of Bassi Road and Lotus Road intersection in 1999, a 2001 bridge repair on Granite Creek Bridge including a bridge deck corrosion inhibitor treatment, and numerous other routine maintenance activities; and

**WHEREAS**, the Department of Transportation, is charged with developing an annual Capital Improvement Program that sets forth all of the road projects the Department intends to design and construct over the next five year period; and

**WHEREAS**, as part of development of the Capital Improvement Program, the Department of Transportation reviewed the road improvements needed in the Bassi Road Corridor Area of Benefit; and

**WHEREAS**, Department of Transportation staff in developing the Capital Improvement Program determined that the widening of the Granite Creek Bridge is not warranted because there are insufficient funds to implement the widening and there is no accident history to indicate there will be any quantifiable increase in safety or other benefits gained; and

**WHEREAS**, Department of Transportation staff, in developing the Capital Improvement Program determined that the realignment of Lupe’s Curve does not warrant the expenditure of funds to purchase Right-of-Way or pursue condemnation efforts because there is no accident history to indicate there will be any quantifiable increase in safety or other benefits gained; and

**WHEREAS**, the Department of Transportation has included a Bassi Road Improvement Project to improve the road condition and geometrics using the Bassi Road Corridor Area of Benefit funds as Project #73306 in the 2008 Capital Improvement Program adopted by the Board of Supervisors on February 12, 2008; and;

**WHEREAS**, the implementation and construction of the newly adopted Capital Improvement Project for Bassi Road (Project #73306) will completely exhaust all funds in the Area of Benefit for the Bassi Road Corridor and such Area of Benefit will no longer be needed.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AS FOLLOWS:**

- A. The Board hereby accepts the Bassi Road Improvement Project included in the adopted 2008 Capital Improvement Program (Project #73306) as the most appropriate project to meet the goals identified in the "Bassi Road Study" accepted by the Department of Transportation in 1987; and
- B. The Board hereby rescinds Resolution 417A-87; and
- C. The Board hereby determines that after completion of the Bassi Road Improvement Project (#73306) the Area of Benefit for the Bassi Road Corridor shall be dissolved.
