




PROJECT NAME: Apalachee Phase 3A Erosion Control Project	PROJECT NUMBER: 95184	DATE OF SUBSTANTIAL COMPLETION September 17, 2007
DESCRIPTION OF THE PROJECT: Construction of erosion control improvements including curb and gutter with tie-in pavement, asphalt concrete and vegetated swales, porous pavement, sediment traps, drainage inlets, culverts, rock-lined channel, rock slope protection, and stormwater retention chambers. These improvements are proposed for construction on the following streets: a portion of Washoan Blvd., Koyukon Dr., Kulow St., Brule St., Hunkpapa St., Minniconjou St., Watson St., Huph St., Panka St., and Canarsee St.		
LOCATION OF PROJECT: In the Tahoe Basin in El Dorado County, east of U.S. Highway 50, and west of Pioneer Trail. The Project area generally is bounded by Pioneer Trail on the southeast, Trout Creek to the east, and the Upper Truckee River and the rescinded Caltrans highway corridor to the west. The Project area includes Tahoe Paradise Additions Nos. 2, 3, 4 & 5.		
PORTIONS OF THE PROJECT TO WHICH THIS NOTICE APPLIES: All work specified in the Contract Documents dated October 2006, and Contract Change Orders 1-9.
