Some Travel Statistics

•CTTC says that travelers to California in 2006 contributed \$93.8 billion to the economy

•In 2006 travel spending in CA generated \$2.1 billion dollars in local taxes & \$3.5 billion in state taxes

•Travel in CA supported 928,700 jobs

•83% of travelers in California ARE Californians. The value in promoting outside of the state is that those from other states and nations stay longer and spend more.

A Few Statistics for El Dorado County

In 2005, travel spending in the county was \$629,300,000 up \$17,400,000 from 2004.

If the increase in travel spending is divided by the entire county promotional budget of \$440,000 there is an impressive return of \$38.86 per dollar spent.

In 2005, tourism throughout the county provided-10,410 jobs creating \$232,000,000 in earnings. In 2006, the county received \$1,527,800 in transient occupancy tax (hotel/motel tax) up from \$1,302,600 in 2004.

TOT or Hotel Motel Tax Revenue for El Dorado County

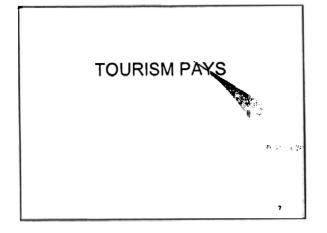

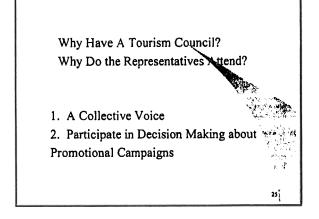
Mission Statement:

The Visitors Authority Council will build the El Dorado County tour am industry as a leading economic engine that increases tax revenues and job creation in a responsible manner.

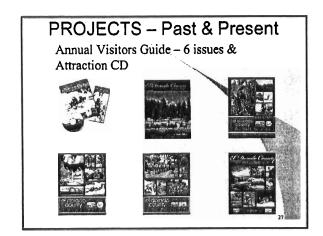
THE VISION
