

**NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING**

The County of El Dorado Planning Commission will hold a public hearing in the Building C Hearing Room, 2850 Fairlane Court, Placerville, CA 95667 on March 26, 2015, at 8:30 a.m., to consider the Sign Ordinance Update submitted by EL DORADO COUNTY which consists of the adoption and implementation of an update to the County's existing Sign Ordinance (Chapter 130.16 of Title 130 of the El Dorado County Code of Ordinances, and other sections of Title 130 addressing sign regulations and standards) as well as amendments to General Plan Objective 2.7.1 and Policy 2.7.1.2 (pertaining to off-site signs) consistent with the goals of the project. The proposed ordinance shall replace the existing Chapter 130.16 pertaining to the regulation of signs in the unincorporated area of the County and shall be treated and considered as a new and comprehensive ordinance which shall supersede all previously adopted standards and ordinances regarding signs. The proposed ordinance applies to general sign requirements, permanent signs, temporary signs, community sign programs, sign development and design standards, permit requirements and review procedures for signs, including prohibited, illegal, abandoned and nonconforming signs, and signs on County property.
