

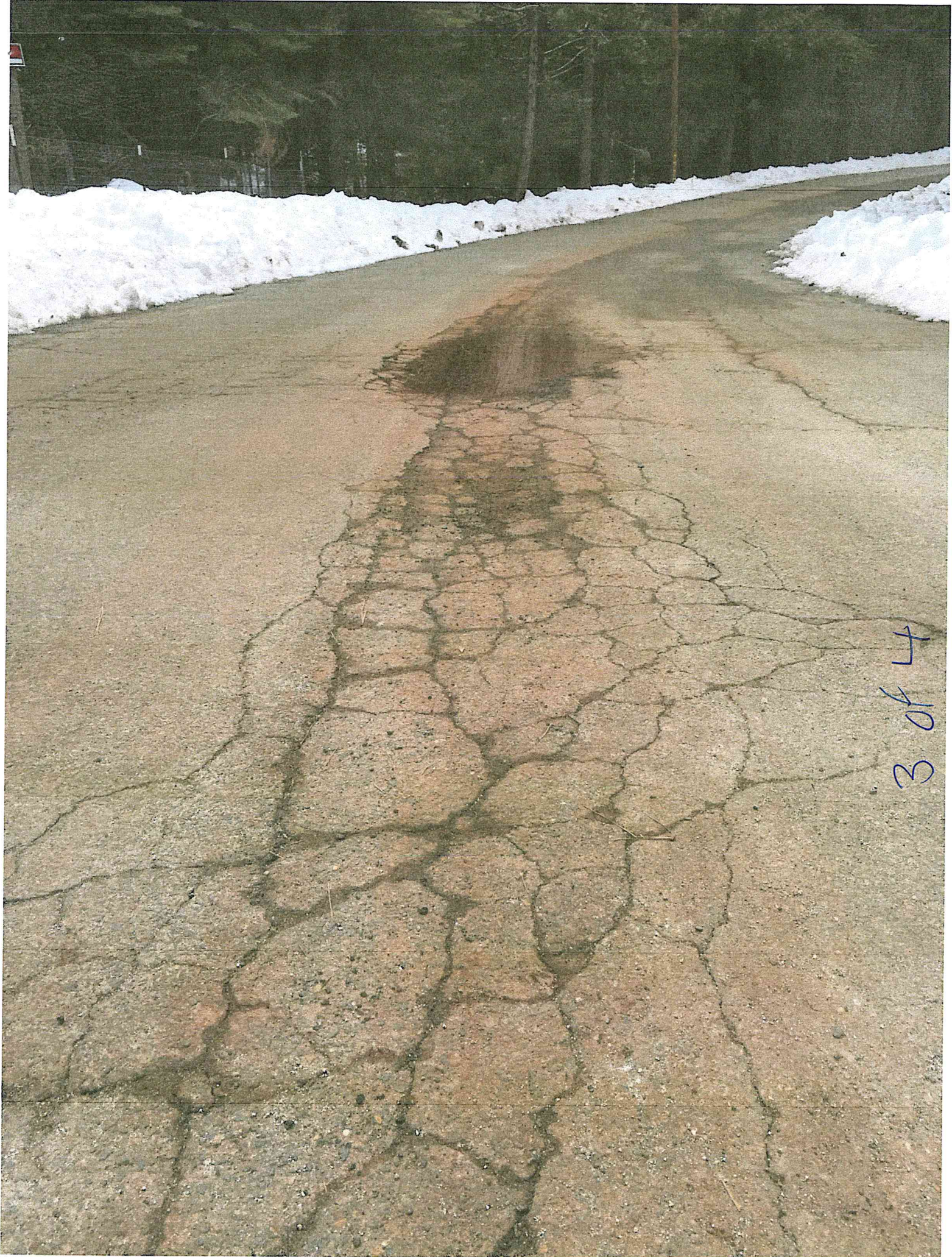

Documentation substantiating the date of hire and date of termination of Deputy Bernard Brown from the El Dorado County Sheriff's Office.



For the record, I did not appreciate your exclusive direction given to Matt Smeltzer to meet with Kris Payne concerning the Mt. Murphy Bridge discrepancies. Although I value Kris' contributions as a former government employee and member of the Historical Society to the project, he is not representative of my community.

Furthermore, your inappropriate comments denigrating my observations and factual, audio recorded statements based on multiple meetings with other county staff and CPRAs was insulting.

FYI, the Brown Act ensures that the public is entitled to approach the podium a second time for brief dialog, clarification or to make an inquiry. Therefore in the interest of government transparency and accountability, it is expected that I be included as a stakeholder in all meetings with Matt Smeltzer and Kris Payne on this CIP project affecting Coloma residents. Whenever possible another community member will accompany me in

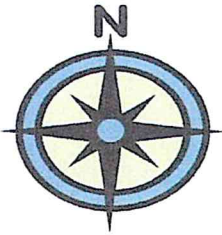
order that the integrity of accurate data be preserved and properly disseminated without the government spin on a predetermined outcome (i.e. Bridge Option #1 vs #2).
