



PROCLAMATION

Of the El Dorado County Board of Supervisors Designating February 2026 as Civil Grand Jury Awareness Month

WHEREAS, the Civil Grand Jury is made up of 19 citizens who serve El Dorado County for a one-year term following selection; and

WHEREAS, the individual Civil Grand Jurors are selected from volunteer applicants that have been screened and qualified by the judges of the Superior Court, with final selection of the 19 obtained by random drawing; and

WHEREAS, the jurisdiction of the Civil Grand Jury extends to all activities of local government within the geographic limits of El Dorado County; and

WHEREAS, the Civil Grand Jury is granted subpoena powers that extend to records, persons and entities, and parallel powers to undertake independent investigations and issue public reports detailing the results of these investigations; and

WHEREAS, the primary function of the Civil Grand Jury is to provide independent oversight into the efficiency, effectiveness, honesty, and impartiality of government by the citizens of El Dorado County; and

WHEREAS, the Civil Grand Jury in large part relies upon public awareness and responsiveness of the public to its reports which detail its findings and recommendations; and


WHEREAS, it is believed that public awareness and responsiveness of the Civil Grand Jury's function and purpose can be furthered by governmental declarations of awareness.


