To the Board of Supervisors:

While these buildings are located within the heart of downtown Placerville, I am not in support of transferring then to the City of Placerville. I reviewed the City's proposal, and find it long on bureaucratic jargon and short on actual actions and benefits.

The current partnership between the City and Arts and Culture El Dorado for the old City Hall and Emigrant Jane (Confidence) buildings has been disappointing. Both buildings still need repairs and have not provided the benefits that were promised. I have personally attended several of the events sponsored by Arts & Culture El Dorado and tried to support their efforts. However, I found them to be substandard when compared to other events in Placerville. This is not a group I would recommend to take over the management of two more historic buildings.

I would support allowing the purchase of both buildings by El Dordo Gold 1848 with appropriate conditions for maintenance of the historic mural, along with repair and maintenance of the buildings.
