OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF EL DORADO

**RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING BENEFIT ASSESSMENTS FOR MOSQUITO
ABATEMENT AND SNOW REMOVAL EQUIPMENT (CITY OF SOUTH LAKE TAHOE)
WITHIN COUNTY SERVICE AREA #3
FISCAL YEAR 2011/2012**

WHEREAS, Mosquito Abatement and Snow Removal are authorized pursuant to Section 25210.77 (a) of Government Code to be provided as extended services within County Service Area No. 3; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors of the County of El Dorado, acting as the governing Board of County Service Area No. 3, has caused to be prepared a written report describing each parcel of property which will be charged for the above referenced services pursuant to Government Code 25210.77 (a); and

WHEREAS, the Board finds that a benefit assessment imposed on each improved parcel within County Service Area No. 3 for Mosquito Abatement, and City of South Lake Tahoe snow removal equipment is the fairest way to apportion the costs of providing said services in accordance with the benefits to be conferred in the service area;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of Supervisors of the County of El Dorado that the following benefit assessments are hereby adopted;

MOSQUITO ABATEMENT - \$6.00 (six dollars) per improved parcel set forth in above referenced report;

SNOW REMOVAL EQUIPMENT (CITY OF SOUTH LAKE TAHOE) - \$20 (twenty dollars) per improved parcel within the boundaries of the CSA No. 3 as set forth in the above referenced report.


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the benefit assessments as adopted and confirmed herein shall appear as separate items on the tax bill for each improved parcel and shall be collected at the same time and in the same manner as County ad valorem taxes are collected, as more specifically set forth and authorized in the subdivision (d) of Section 25210.77 (a) of the Government Code; and


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors is hereby authorized and directed to transmit copies of the Resolution to the El Dorado County Assessor, Auditor-Controller and Treasurer-Tax Collector for implementation as authorized by law.

| City SLT Snow Removal | \$20 | Snow Removal Equipment – The City of South Lake Tahoe established a JPA in 1989 for the purchase of snow removal equipment within the <i>City of South Lake Tahoe (SLT)</i> . The City of SLT Public Works Department is responsible for the overall program. Environmental Management administers the collection of benefit assessment. The proposed benefit assessment remains the same. Revenue generated by these assessments are a direct pass through to the City of South Lake Tahoe. |
| CSA 3 Mosquito Abatement | \$6 | Mosquito Abatement – The Mosquito Abatement Program, established in 1963, is applicable to <i>City and County parcels within the Tahoe Basin</i> for Mosquito Control. Other programs funded through these fees are plague surveillance and the control of yellow jackets. It is administered by the Environmental Management Department, Vector Control Division. The proposed benefit assessment remains the same. |
