Comments Re: The proposed Forebay Park Project in Pollock Pines.

As a homeowner on Romer Blvd directly adjacent to the proposed Forebay Park Project, I request that you please notify all property owners on Romer and within a mile radius, by US Mail, about anything to do with the proposed project and how to comment on it, in advance.

So far we have not received such written notification and were very surprised to see that updates posted on social media or on the website indicated that designs were based on public surveys.

As a homeowner directly adjacent to the park and proposed new playground areas, I never received notification of such surveys, and feel that certain aspects of the proposed designs are quite concerning, and need to be thought out further, including the proposed public grill areas for example. Given that Pollock Pines is in a high fire zone and fire insurance is already very expensive in the area, having public bbq grills in the forest and next to homes is not a safe idea.

Again, as a homeowner directly impacted by the Forebay Park Improvements Project, I (and I'm sure my neighbors) would appreciate having an opportunity to be kept notified about this project and given a real opportunity to comment and provide important input on this and other aspects of the project in our neighborhood.
