### OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF EL DORADO

*Recognizing efforts of County staff and aligned personnel that assisted our Community during the recent Trailhead Fire event*

*Whereas, On June 28, 2016 the Trailhead Fire was ignited in El Dorado County, at a time of drought and in areas with high fuel loads; and*

*Whereas, El Dorado County fire and public safety personnel provided immediate response, the Trailhead fire quickly grew to engulf thousands of acres and threaten lives and homes which necessitated mutual aid response from statewide fire and public safety agencies; and*

*Whereas, Through dedicated service, firefighters, Sheriff Deputies and personnel, animal service officers, Public Health Emergency Preparedness staff, and other County employees assisted the community during the Trailhead Fire event; and*

*Whereas, members of the community, including Mr. Tim Sauer and Mrs. Danielle Slater, the South County Large Animal Rescue Organization and the Black Oak Mine Unified School District donated time and resources to provide essential assistance relative the evacuation of animals and livestock,*

*Now, Therefore, be it Proclaimed, that the El Dorado County Board of Supervisors, on behalf of the residents of El Dorado County, honor and extend heartfelt gratitude to the dedicated service of firefighters, Sheriff Deputies and personnel, animal service officers, Public Health Emergency Preparedness staff, and other County employees and community members who assisted the community during the Trailhead Fire event*
