CACVSO Winter Training Conference:

VSO Jonathan Brown and VSR I Christopher Diggins attended the CACVSO Winter Training Conference in Wheatland, CA, from February 23rd to 28th. The conference covered various subjects, including regulation changes that will affect claims for Sleep Apnea and Tinnitus. One of the most significant changes will be to the rating schedule for Sleep Apnea. Currently, if a veteran is service-connected for Sleep Apnea and uses a CPAP machine, they receive a 50% Service-Connected (SC) rating. However, with the upcoming changes by the Veterans Affairs (VA), the same veteran will receive a 0% SC rating.

Previously, I reported similar changes that the VA plans to implement for Tinnitus. The VA will no longer grant a SC disability rating for Tinnitus on its own; instead, it will be considered a symptom of another condition and will only enhance the SC rating for the primary issue. Veterans with existing SC ratings for Sleep Apnea or Tinnitus will not see changes in their ratings unless they submit a claim related to these conditions. If a veteran submits a claim for another condition, the VA will not reassess their ratings for Sleep Apnea or Tinnitus. These changes are scheduled to take effect in July of this year.
