Recommendation:

The Department of Transportation recommends that the Board of Supervisors approve for final adoption, amendments to Title 3, Chapter 3.14 of the El Dorado County Ordinance Code to reflect revisions in the informal bidding limits for public projects contained in Public Contract Code Sections 22032 and 22034 which became effective July 1, 2005.

The proposed amendments to Title 3, Chapter 3.14 of the Ordinance Code have been reviewed and approved by County Counsel.

Background:

At the Board of Supervisors meeting of May 16, 2006, agenda item #11, your Board approved in concept amendments to Title 3, Chapter 3.14 of the El Dorado County Ordinance Code to reflect revisions in the informal bidding limits for public projects. Your Board directed County Counsel to prepare a draft version of the amended Ordinance and to present the final ordinance amendments to the Board for adoption. The amendments were introduced at the September 26, 2006 meeting (agenda item #38) where your Board waived reading and continued the matter to October 17, 2006 for final adoption.

Reasons for Recommendations:

Adoption of the amendments to the Ordinance Code will enable the Department of Transportation and other authorized County departments to use public agency or negotiated contracts for projects estimated to cost up to \$30,000; will allow informal bidding procedures for projects estimated to cost up to \$125,000; and will allow your Board to award contracts up to \$137,500, when bids solicited through the informal bidding process are all in excess of

\$125,000. These changes will enable the County's Ordinance Code to conform to the Public Contract Code.

Fiscal Impact:

There is no direct fiscal impact associated with approval of amendments to County Ordinance Code Chapter 3.14.

Action to be Taken Following Approval:

Adopt and incorporate amendments to Title 3, Chapter 3.14 of the El Dorado County Ordinance Code, which amendments shall become effective thirty (30) days following adoption by the Board of Supervisors.
