In accordance with the Contract Documents, Notice to Bidders, Protest Procedures, page N-4, a Bidder must submit a formal written Protest to the Procurement & Contracts Division of the Chief Administrative Office within five (5) working days of the County's Notice of Intent to Award.

Pursuant to Section 20128 of the Public Contract Code, this item is scheduled to be awarded by the Board of Supervisors on Tuesday, May 14, 2019. All bids are on file in the Procurement & Contracts Office, and are available for review by appointment between 8:00 a.m. - 12:00 p.m. and 1:00 p.m. - 5:00 p.m., Monday through Friday.
