NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Cameron Park Community Services District ("District") intends to conduct a public hearing on January 17, 2007 at 7 P.M. to consider a resolution concerning the approval of the District's Park Impact Fee Nexus Study and approval of new park impact fees charged on new residential development pursuant to California Government Code Section 66000 et. al. and El Dorado County Code Chapter 18.30. The Public Hearing shall be held at the Cameron Park Community Services District Boardroom located at 3200 Country Club Drive, Cameron Park, California. The Park Impact Fee Nexus Study for the proposed park impact fees will be available for public review on January 2, 2007.
