Resolution for Road Closure for the 2014  
“Cowboy Gathering on the Georgetown Divide”

**WHEREAS**, The American River Folk Society (sponsor) desires to hold the “Cowboy Gathering on the Georgetown Divide” on Saturday, October 18 and Sunday, October 19, 2014; and

**WHEREAS**, said sponsors have applied for a Road Closure Permit pursuant to Vehicle Code 21101(e), Ordinance Code §12.37.010 et seq., and County Resolution 110-79 in order to promote the “Cowboy Gathering on the Georgetown Divide” on Saturday, October 18 and Sunday, October 19, 2014; and

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** that a road closure be in effect for Main Street in Georgetown on both sides of the street from Hwy 193 to Placer Street. It will be closed on the North side of the street only between Placer Street and Orleans Street. The South side of the street will remain open to traffic traveling eastbound. Placer Street will remain open to through traffic and Orleans Street will remain open to through traffic for the “Cowboy Gathering on the Georgetown Divide”, subject to conditions set forth in Resolution No. 110-79 dated May 1, 1979, and subject to conditions set forth in the “Application for Road Closure” submitted for this event.

This Resolution and the Application with conditions shall together constitute the Road Closure Permit.
