Resolution for Road Closure for the 2015  
“Sugarloaf Stampede Run”

**WHEREAS**, the El Dorado County Office of Education and the Sugarloaf Station Foundation (sponsor) desires to hold the “Sugarloaf Stampede Run” Event on Saturday, April 18, 2015; and

**WHEREAS**, said sponsors have applied for a Road Closure Permit pursuant to Vehicle Code 21101(e), Ordinance Code §12.37.010 et seq., and County Resolution 110-79 in order to promote the “Sugarloaf Stampede Run” Event on Saturday, April 18, 2015; and

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** that a road closure will be in effect for Jacquier Road only. This event is scheduled for Saturday, April 18, 2015 from 8:00 a.m. to 11:00 a.m., for the “Sugarloaf Stampede Run”, subject to conditions set forth in Resolution No. 110-79 dated May 1, 1979, and subject to conditions set forth in the Application for Road Closure submitted for this event.


This Resolution and the Application with conditions shall together constitute the Road Closure Permit.
