**Resolution for Road Closure for the
“Pleasant Valley 4th of July Parade”**

WHEREAS, the Pleasant Valley Grange #675 (sponsor) desires to hold the “Pleasant Valley 4th of July Parade” on Friday, July 4, 2014; and

WHEREAS, said sponsors have applied for a Road Closure Permit pursuant to Vehicle Code 21102(e), Ordinance Code §12.37.010 et seq., and County Resolution 110-79 in order to promote the “Pleasant Valley 4th of July Parade” on Friday, July 4, 2014; and


NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that a road closure will be in effect for Pleasant Valley Road between Leisure Lane and Mt. Aukum Road (E-16). Additionally, road barricades will be located at the intersections of Pleasant Valley Road and Beau Val Lane, Alameda Road and Strauss Drive on Friday, July 4, 2014 from 11:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m., for the “Pleasant Valley 4th of July Parade,” subject to conditions set forth in Resolution No. 110-79 dated May 1, 1979, and subject to the conditions set forth in the Application for Road Closure, submitted for this event.

This Resolution and the Application with conditions shall together constitute the Road Closure Permit.
