



RESOLUTION NO. 042-2025

OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF EL DORADO

WHEREAS, representatives of the County of El Dorado and representatives of the El Dorado County Employee's Association, Local No. 1, AFCSME Council 57 (Union), representing employees in the General (GE), Professional (PL), and Supervisory (SU) bargaining units (collectively, the Parties) have met and negotiated in good faith since August 29, 2023; and

WHEREAS, said representatives have reached an agreement on a variety of terms and conditions of employment for employees in the GE, PL, and SU bargaining units to be incorporated as the successor Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) for the period covering January 1, 2025 through December 31, 2026; and

WHEREAS, members of the Union representing employees in the GE, PL, and SU bargaining units have held election(s) and voted to ratify the negotiated terms and conditions contained within the tentative agreement for the successor MOU; and,

WHEREAS, the previous MOU between the Parties expires upon adoption of this successor MOU, and the Parties are now bringing the negotiated and fully executed successor MOU that is attached and incorporated herein to the Board of Supervisors for final approval.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board of Supervisors of the County of El Dorado approves, adopts, and authorizes the Chair to sign this Resolution and the successor Memorandum of Understanding that is attached and incorporated herein between the County of El Dorado and the El Dorado County Employee's Association, Local No. 1, AFCSME Council 57, representing employees in the General, Professional, and Supervisory bargaining units, for the period January 1, 2025 through December 31, 2026.
