



RESOLUTION NO. 193-2014
OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF EL DORADO

WHEREAS, the City of Placerville and El Dorado County continue to work together for the benefit of our community; and

WHEREAS, the Placerville Aquatic Center is located at 3071 Benham Street, Placerville CA 95667; and

WHEREAS, in the past the El Dorado County Board of Supervisors has been sympathetic to the fact that 70% of the people who attend the City of Placerville Aquatics Center reside outside the City limits; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Placerville on June 24, 2014 adopted resolution 8210, requesting assistance in the amount of \$20,000 to offset some of the maintenance and operational costs associated with providing a comprehensive aquatics program during the summer months; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Government Code §25553, the El Dorado Board of Supervisors desires to grant the City's request for aid; and

WHEREAS this aid shall be used by the City of Placerville within one year from the time it is extended by the county and any sum or property remaining at the end of the year shall be returned to the county; and

WHEREAS, the City of Placerville shall report the disposition of the aid made by the Board of Supervisors within one year from the time it is received.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the El Dorado County Board of Supervisors awards \$20,000 to the City of Placerville for the Placerville Aquatic Center located at 3071 Benham Street, Placerville, CA 95667 to offset maintenance and operational costs associated with people who reside outside the City limits and participate in the aquatics program.
