FUNDING AGREEMENT WITH THE

EL DORADO COUNTY FIRE SAFE COUNCIL

AGM #115-F1011

THIS AGREEMENT made and entered into by and between the County of El Dorado, a political subdivision of the State of California (hereinafter referred to as "County") and the El Dorado Fire Safe Council, organized under the California Nonprofit Public Benefit Laws for charitable purposes within the meaning of Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, whose principal place of business is 2860 Mt. Danaher Road, Camino, CA 95709;

RECITALS

WHEREAS, The mission of the El Dorado County Fire Safe Council is "to protect the people of El Dorado County and their property from the effects of catastrophic wildfire through education, cooperation, innovation, and action; and

WHEREAS, El Dorado County Fire Safe Council activities promote awareness about the risks of living within a Wildland Urban Interface (WUI) and provide education on what people in homes, businesses and subdivisions can do to protect their property from wildfire through the creation of defensible space and other strategies; and

WHEREAS, El Dorado County Fire Safe Council includes representation from communities throughout the western slope of the county, and access to forestry and fire prevention experts; and

WHEREAS, County has determined that it is in the best interest of the public and the residents of El Dorado County to assist El Dorado County Fire Safe Council activities by contributing a portion of its fiscal year 2008-09 allocation authorized through Title III of the Secure Rural Schools and Community Self Determination Act (Public Law 110-343) to assist the El Dorado County Fire Safe Council in fulfilling its mission;

NOW, THEREFORE, County and the El Dorado County Fire Safe Council mutually agree as follows:

ARTICLE I

Payment of Funds: County will contribute the sum of \$210,458 to the El Dorado County Fire Safe Council solely for the purpose of funding fire prevention and planning projects as described in Title III of Public Law 110-343.

ARTICLE II

Use of Funds: El Dorado County Fire Safe Council will use the funds solely for the purpose of funding fire prevention and planning projects as described in Title III of Public Law 110-343.

Authorized use of funds received through this contract are:

- to carry out activities under the Firewise Communities program to provide to homeowners in fire-sensitive ecosystems education on, and assistance with implementing, techniques in home siting, home construction, and home landscaping that can increase the protection of people and property from wildfires;
- 2) to develop community wildfire protection plans in coordination with the appropriate Secretary concerned.

Before awarding any portion of the county's Title III funds to any sub-recipient or engaging in a transaction for any amount involving these funds, El Dorado County Fire Safe Council will check for suspension and debarment of sub-recipients through the Excluded Parties List System available online at: http://www.epls.gov. El Dorado County Fire Safe Council may not award or engage in any transaction involving county Title III funds with suspended or debarred parties.

Commencing on the 10th day of the first full month immediately following the day funds are paid by County to the El Dorado County Fire Safe Council and each 10th day of the month thereafter until all funds are utilized, the El Dorado County Fire Safe Council shall submit to County its statement noting the funds used to date and detailing how and what fire prevention and planning projects were funded. Such statement shall be substantially in form of Attachment A to this Agreement and signed under penalty of perjury by an authorized officer of the El Dorado County Fire Safe Council.

ARTICLE III

Term: This Agreement shall become effective when fully executed by both parties, and following the expiration of the 45-day public comment period as required by Title III Section 302(b) which commenced on July 31, 2009 and ends on September 14, 2009, and shall expire on June 30, 2012.

ARTICLE IV

Audit: For a period of three (3) years after the termination of this Agreement, the El Dorado County Fire Safe Council will keep and maintain an accurate financial account, in accordance with generally accepted accounting principals, of all funds expended by the El Dorado County Fire Safe Council for fire prevention and planning projects. Such accounting records shall be available for inspection by the County's designee, during normal business hours at the offices of the El Dorado County Fire Safe Council, or offices of its financial consultant.

ARTICLE V

Compliance with Applicable Law: El Dorado County Fire Safe Council will comply with all Federal, State, and local laws and ordinances which are applicable to its programs and projects, including but not limited to non-discrimination provisions.

ARTICLE VI

El Dorado County Fire Safe Council Liability: El Dorado County Fire Safe Council is, and shall be at all times, deemed independent and shall be wholly responsible for the acts of El

Dorado County Fire Safe Council employees, associates, and contractors in connection with its projects.

ARTICLE VII

No Third Party Beneficiary: Nothing in this Agreement shall be construed to create any rights of any kind or nature in any other party not a named party to this Agreement.

ARTICLE VIII

Termination: County may terminate this Agreement in the event El Dorado County Fire Safe Council ceases to operate or otherwise becomes unable to substantially perform any terms or conditions of the Agreement. In the event of early termination of the Agreement, unexpended funds previously received from County shall be returned to County within thirty (30) days of termination.

ARTICLE IX

Notice to Parties: All notices to be given by the parties hereto shall be in writing and served by depositing same in the United States Post Office, postage prepaid and return receipt requested. Notices to County shall be in duplicate and addressed as follows:

or to such other location as El Dorado County Fire Safe Council directs.

ARTICLE X

Indemnity: El Dorado County Fire Safe Council shall defend, indemnify, and hold the County harmless against and from any and all claims, suits, losses, damages, and liability for damages of every name, kind, and description, including attorneys fees and costs incurred, brought for, or on account of, injuries to or death of any person, including, but not limited to workers, County employees, and the public, or damage to property, or any economic or consequential losses, which are claimed to or in any way arise out of or are connected with the El Dorado County Fire Safe Council. This duty of El Dorado County Fire Safe Council to indemnify and save County harmless includes the duties to defend set forth in California Civil Code section 2778 and survives the expiration of the term of this Agreement.

ARTICLE XI

Insurance: El Dorado County Fire Safe Council shall provide proof of a policy of insurance or self-insured program satisfactory to the El Dorado County Risk Manager and documentation evidencing that El Dorado County Fire Safe Council maintains insurance or self-insurance for Workers Compensation, if applicable, Commercial General Liability Insurance and Automobile Insurance. El Dorado County Fire Safe Council agrees that the insurance required above shall be in effect at all times during the term of this Agreement.

ARTICLE XII

Change to Agreement: This Agreement may be amended by mutual consent of the parties hereto. Said amendments shall become effective only when in writing and fully executed by duly authorized officers of the parties hereto.

ARTICLE XIII

Administrator: The County Officer or employee with responsibility for administering this Agreement is Gayle Erbe-Hamlin, Chief Administrative Officer or successor.

ARTICLE XIV

Authorized Signatures: The parties to this Agreement represent that the undersigned individuals executing this Agreement on their respective behalf are fully authorized to do so by law or other appropriate instrument and to bind upon said parties to the obligations set forth herein.

ARTICLE XV

Partial Invalidity: If any provision of this Agreement is held by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, void or unenforceable, the remaining provisions will continue in full force and effect without being impaired or invalidated in any way.

ARTICLE XVI

Venue: Any dispute resolution action arising out of this Agreement, including, but not limited to, litigation, mediation, or arbitration, shall be brought in El Dorado County, California, and shall be resolved in accordance with the laws of the State of California. El Dorado County Fire Safe Council waives any removal rights it might have under Code of Civil Procedure section 394.

ARTICLE XVII

Entire Agreement: This document and the documents referred to herein or exhibits hereto are the entire agreement between the parties, and they incorporate or supersede all prior written or oral Agreements or understandings.

ARTICLE XVIII

Time is of the Essence: The parties hereto acknowledge and agree that time is of the essence.
