
Road Closure Authorization Memo for Happy Valley Road

This Project consists drainage, roadway, retaining wall and ditch improvements to repair a failed culvert and section of the roadway that includes: installing 60 inch storm drainage manhole with grate, installing 30-inch reinforced concrete pipe culvert, micropile retaining structure, removal of an existing 16-inch steel culvert, roadway excavation, placing new roadway structural section, installing rock slope protection, and tree removal. The roadway will be closed for the duration of this Project. This closure will require road closure signs and Portable Changeable Message Sign (PCMS) placement on both sides of the Project per the attached Detour Plan.

This Project is a thirty (30) working day Project. Happy Valley Road will be fully closed to traffic for forty-three (43) calendar days as shown on the attached Detour Plan. Access for local residents and visitors, as well as emergency personnel and law enforcement will be via detour to Mount Aukum Road or Happy Valley Cut Off Road per the attached Detour Plan. Transportation will notify the public of this road closure via the County website, a press release, and PCMS boards at least one week in advance of starting work.


The dates of the closure will be approximately from May 1, 2018 through June 12, 2018. The actual dates will be confirmed with the above referenced notifications once the Contract is awarded, weather conditions suitable for the Project are verified, and the work dates are known. The Contractor's insurance certification will be submitted to Risk Management with the Contract Package.





