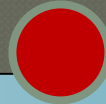

“What to Expect”



Construction

- ✓ Costs: Capital \$62 Million, CM = \$8.5 Million
- ✓ Planned to Begin Spring 2022
- ✓ Construction Estimated 2 – 3 years
- ✓ Heavy Equipment & Trucks
- ✓ Intermittent Lane Closures
- ✓ Road closures up to 10 weeks per year
 - ✓ Similar closure periods to existing annual bridge maintenance
- ✓ Public Outreach on website, news media, & roadway message boards
