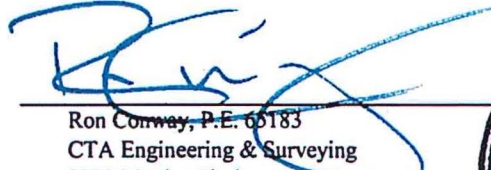
I estimate the total cost of completing the improvements agreed to be performed by the Owner to be **Nine Hundred Five Thousand One Hundred Seventy-Three Dollars and Thirty-One Cents (\$905,173.31)**.

I estimate the total cost of completing the remainder of the improvements to be **Three Hundred Twenty-Nine Thousand One Hundred Ten Dollars and Seventy-Five Cents (\$329,110.75)** and the cost of the completed work to be **Five Hundred Seventy-Six Thousand Sixty-Two Dollars and Fifty-Six Cents (\$576,062.56)**.

The revised amount of the Performance Bond is **Three Hundred Twenty-Nine Thousand One Hundred Ten Dollars and Seventy-Five Cents (\$329,110.75)**, representing 100% of the Total Remaining Amount.

The amount of the Laborers and Materialmens Bond is **Four Hundred Fifty-Two Thousand Five Hundred Eighty-Six Dollars and Sixty-Six Cents (\$452,586.66)**, which is 50% of the Total Cost of the Improvements.

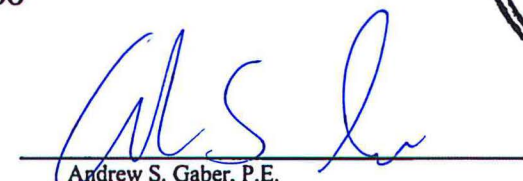
